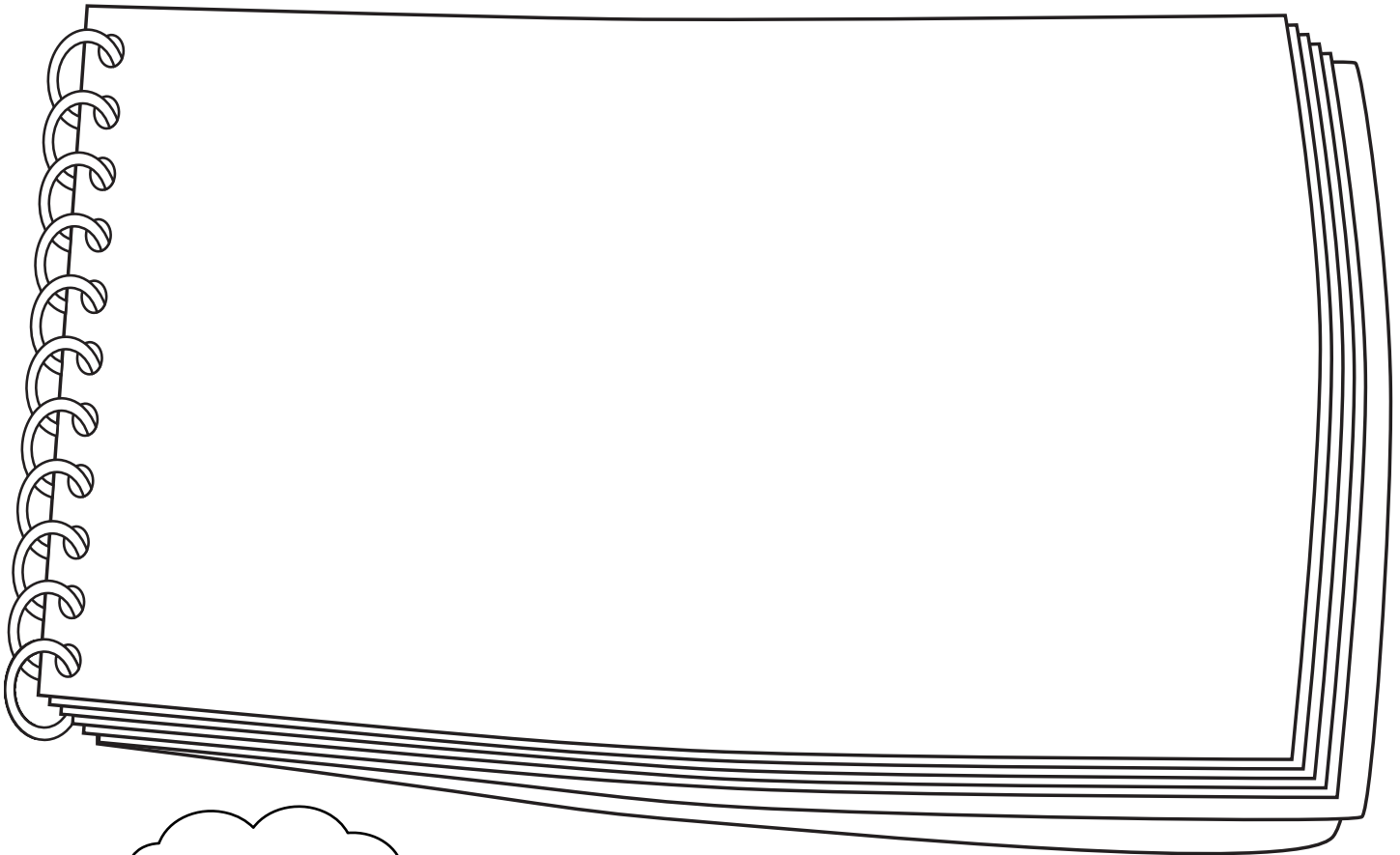
2 Samuel 7 (NIRV)
