
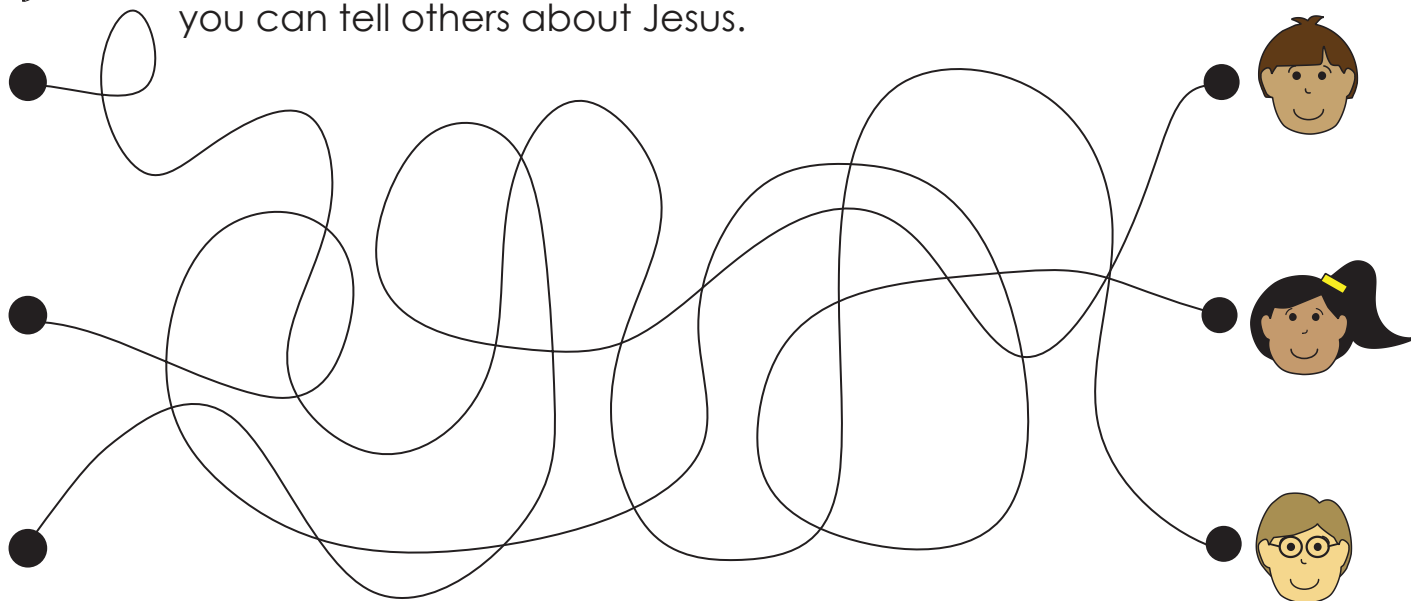



# Line Maze
